Required Equipment – Off-Road Vehicles Jeep/Truck

Jack and lug wrench
Full size spare tire (if possible to carry a spare)
Fire Extinguisher
First Aid Kit
Tow Strap, no metal hooks
Tool Kit for trail repairs
Tow Hooks or Strap Point, Front and Rear
Seat Belts or Harnesses for all passengers
GMRS Radio Unit (Handheld or Mounted)
Valid Driver's License
Winch, Come-a-Long, or Hi-Lift Jack
Proof of Vehicle Insurance (minimum of liability)

Required Equipment – ATV/UTV

Helmet
Gloves
GMRS Radio Unit (Handheld or Mounted)
First Aid Kit

Optional Gear and Equipment

Lunch and Drinks
Trash bags (pack it in, pack it out)
Gas Can
Shovel
Oil and other fluids
Tarps, other Wet Weather Gear
Tire Repair Toolkit
Cell Phone with 12-Volt Charger
CB Radio (40 Channel)
Trail Maps
