Optional Gear and Equipment Lunch and Drinks Trash bags (pack it in, pack it out) Gas Can Shovel Oil and other fluids Tarps, other Wet Weather Gear Tire Repair Toolkit Cell Phone with 12-Volt Charger CB Radio (40 Channel) Trail Maps
